We are excited to announce that the second issue of *The Mailer Review* will be published in September 2008. The membership price includes a copy of this prestigious journal. ***You are encouraged to join by August 10 as it will greatly assist with bulk mailing.*** Otherwise, the shipping of individual issues after this date becomes expensive.

If you wish to become a Benefactor of *The Mailer Review*, we need to learn of pledges **by July 31**. There are three categories of donors: Sponsors (\$100 to \$249), Patrons (\$250 to \$999) and Angels (\$1,000 or more). All donors' names will be listed on Page One of the forthcoming issue.

2008 Norman Mailer Society Conference

The 2008 Norman Mailer Society Conference will be held at The Provincetown Inn on October 15 – 16. The theme of the conference is **Norman Mailer: Memory and the Afterlife**. Conference registration fee for a Society Member is \$135, and the registration fee for a Student is \$80. ***Only 2008 members or Individual LIFE members of the Society can attend the 2008 Conference.*** Those who have been selected to be presenters at the Conference must be 2008 members of The Society and register for the Conference.

Mr. Christopher Ricks, Professor of Poetry at Oxford University and the William M. and Sara B. Warren Professor of Humanities at Boston University, will be the keynote speaker at the October 18 Luncheon.
